

RESOLUTION NO. RES-24-0043

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ORDERING, PROCLAIMING, CALLING, GIVING NOTICE OF AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ON TUESDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2024, FOR THE ELECTION OF ONE (1) CITY COUNCILMEMBER FROM THE FOURTH COUNCIL DISTRICT FOR A FULL TERM OF FOUR (4) YEARS COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY OF DECEMBER, 2024; AND ADOPTING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE TRANSLATIONS OF AND THE CHARGES FOR COSTS OF CANDIDATE STATEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-23-0155, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, March 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Nominating Election was held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, and certain candidates have been nominated for the office of Councilmember for the Fourth City Council District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, it is necessary for the City Council to order, proclaim and call a General Municipal Election for the election of Councilmember for the Fourth City Council District;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the Elections Codes, a General Municipal Election is ordered, proclaimed and called to be held

1 in the City of Long Beach, California, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the  
2 5th day of November, 2024, for the purpose of electing a Member of the City Council for  
3 the Fourth Council District, for a full term of four (4) years, commencing with the third  
4 Tuesday of December, 2024. The following list of candidates which has been regularly  
5 certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the  
6 office of Member of the City Council for the Fourth Council District:

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11 Section 2. Notice is given of the holding and of the time and place of the  
12 election.

13 Section 3. The polls for the General Municipal Election shall be open at  
14 7:00 a.m. and shall be kept open until 8:00 p.m. when the polls shall be closed; except that,  
15 if at the hour of closing there are any voters in the vote center or in line at the door who are  
16 qualified to vote, and who have not been able to do so since appearing, the polls shall be  
17 kept open a sufficient time to enable them to vote; but no one who arrives at the polling  
18 place after 8:00 p.m. shall be entitled to vote, although the polls may be open when such  
19 person arrives.

20 Section 4. California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a  
21 candidate's statement must be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further,  
22 in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73) all  
23 candidates' statements shall be translated into the languages indicated for Member of the  
24 City Council for the Fourth Council District as follows: Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog,  
25 and Vietnamese. A candidate shall not be required to pay for the cost of translating his or  
26 her candidate's statement into any foreign language required pursuant to federal and/or  
27 state law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay the cost of printing the candidate's  
28 statement in the sample ballot pamphlet in the English and/or Spanish language.

1                   Section 5.     Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a  
2 charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statements  
3 sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement  
4 the charge for the costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing any candidate  
5 statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or  
6 inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in accordance  
7 with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309.

8                   Section 6.     The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's  
9 representative with a copy of the resolution.

10                  Section 7.     This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
11 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
