### CFA Towne Center Re-Opening TODAY!

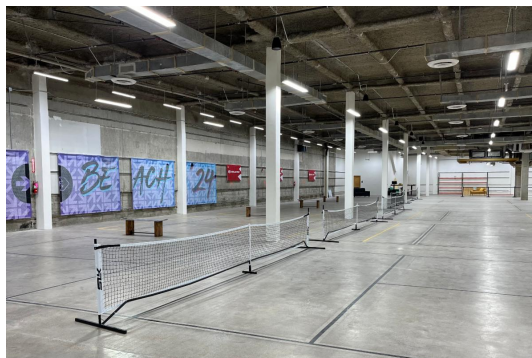
Monday - Saturday | 6:30 am - 10 pm | 7681 E Carson St.

### El Dorado Park Mural Project Now Underway

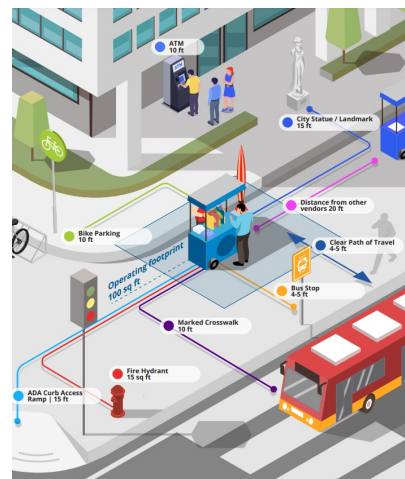

## Sidewalk Vending Ordinance Update

At the October 15th Sidewalk Vending Ordinance update to City Council, staff shared details on a project to revamp data collection for concerns/inspections/enforcement related to sidewalk vending. This initiative aims to improve information and streamline data across both the Health and Financial Management Departments. ## **Water Main Bridge Crossings Repair Project**

**Work ongoing until March 23rd, 2025 | 7 am - 4 pm | Anaheim Rd/Los Cerritos Channel**

Long Beach Utilities released an advanced notice of work planned for the water main bridge at Anaheim Road and Los Cerritos Channel. Work includes removing the exterior paint system on the pipe and applying a new paint system, scaffolding, rigging, and containment of sites and disposal of hazardous materials. The work is ongoing until March 23rd, 2025. Construction hours will be between 7 am and 4 pm. Please anticipate minor traffic delays due to the ongoing work, and use caution when driving in the construction area. 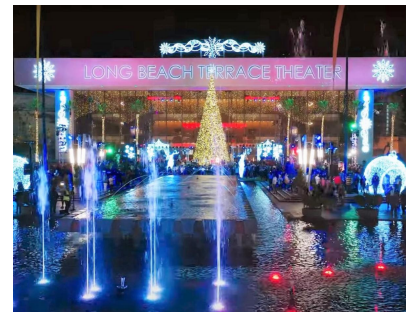

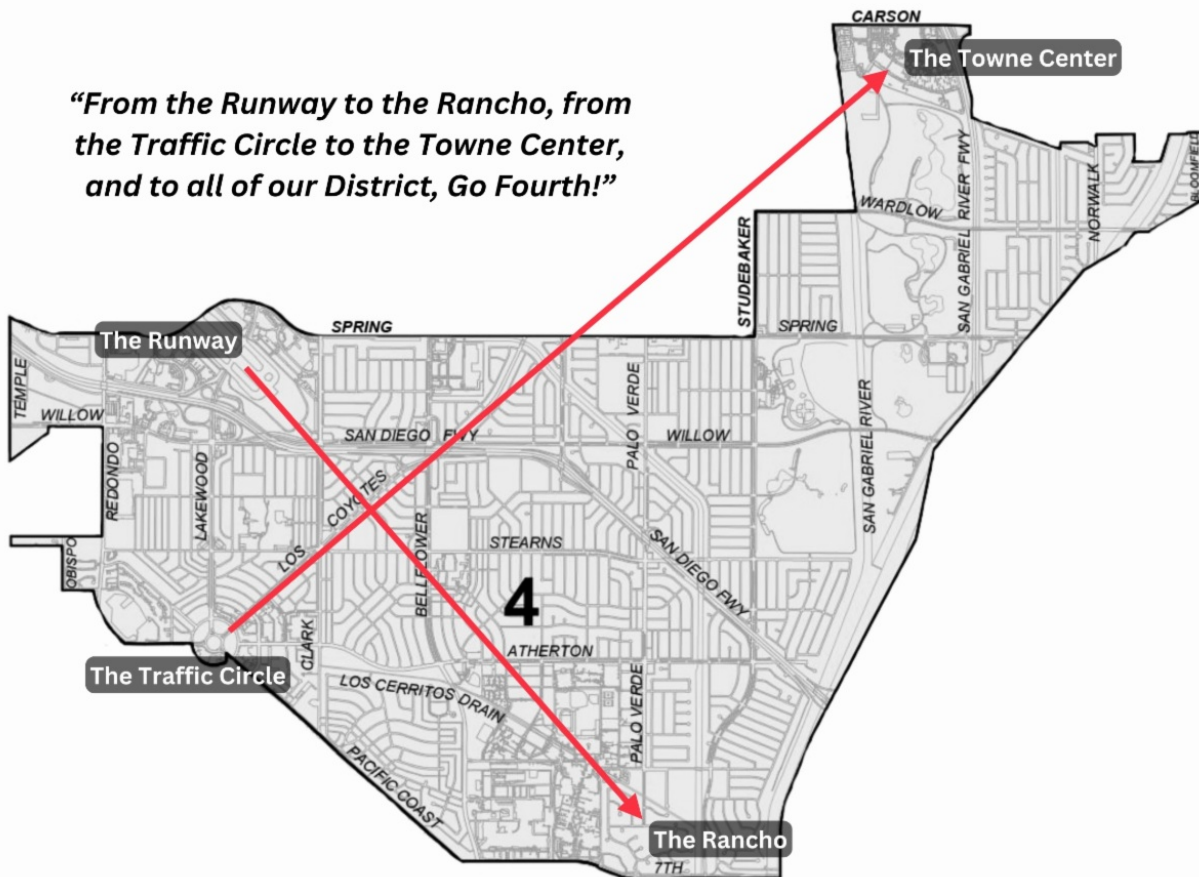
### Commemorating the 500th GF!F Newsletter

In commemoration of today's 500th edition, we have changed the photo montage that appears at the top of every newsletter. Hof's Hut Restaurant has been replaced with District 4 Pizza, and the order of the images has been adjusted. The photos now read as a map of the district appearing in their correct N/S, E/W positions. The images now reflect our new catch phrase: "From the Runway to the Rancho, from the Traffic Circle to the Towne Center, and to all of our District, Go Fourth!" The phrase was inspired by the late television news anchor, Jerry Dunphy, who began every broadcast with, "From the desert to the sea, to all of Southern California, good evening". The last time we changed the photos was in December 2021 to accommodate CD4 boundary "adjustments" enacted with redistricting. Redistricting took place on 12/20/21, so this was the last time we featured Cambodia Town, Joe Jost's, Community Hospital and the Long Beach Playhouse.
